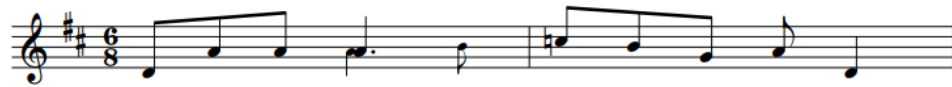

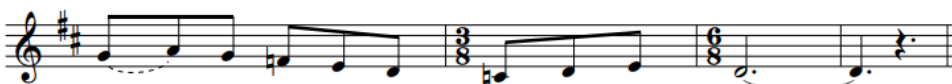

the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

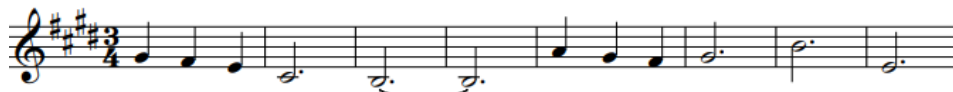

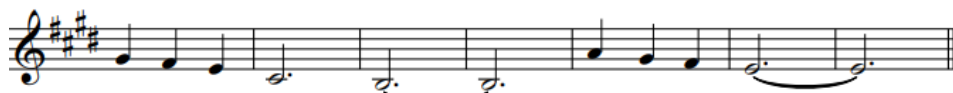
Preparation of the Gifts: "Open My Eyes"






