To be loved as to love with all my soul. (to verse 1)

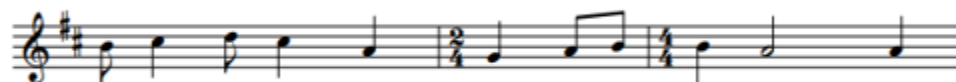
