Sweeter also than syrup or honey from the comb.

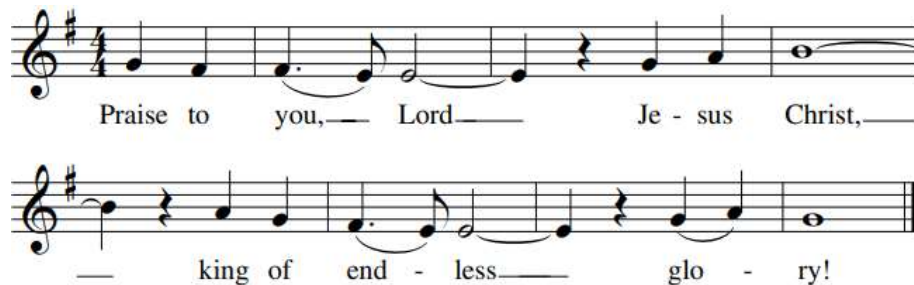
### A reading from the first Letter of Paul to the Corinthians (1:22-25)
