REFRAIN:

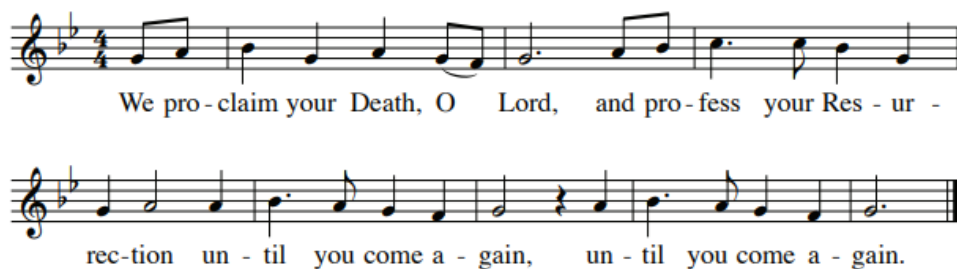
