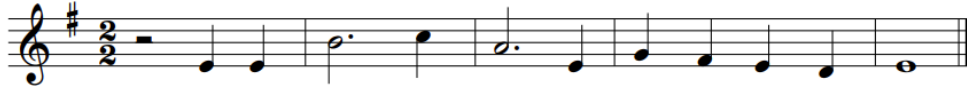
LITURGY of the WORD


