




Liturgy of the Word

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.




I believe in one holy, catholic and apostolic Church.

I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen. GENERAL INTERCESSIONS


