
### A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (9:26-31)

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.













LORD'S PRAYER SIGN OF PEACE
