

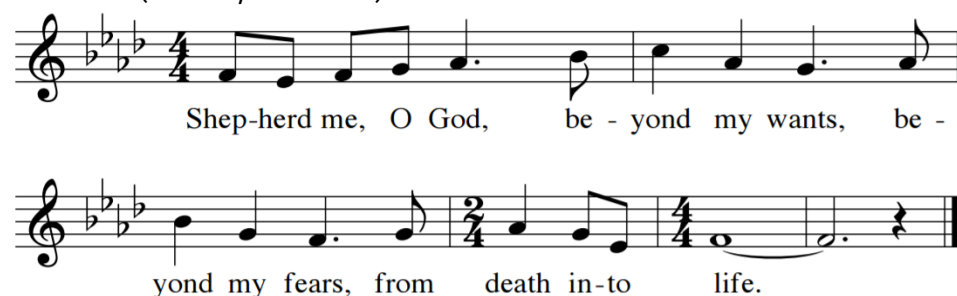
A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (2:14a, 36-41)
