FROM THE DESK OF FR. BILLY DODGE

This Sunday we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. We associate the word "epiphany" with having a breakthrough idea, some kind of new revelation. The epiphany we celebrate this Sunday is the discovery of the newborn Jesus by the gentile (aka non-Jewish) people in the persons of the Magi. I write this article from St. Louis, MO, at the SEEK conference. There are 20,000 people here seeking a greater epiphany of Jesus. I was blown away walking into the the old St. Louis Rams Football Stadium for the opening Mass. All these people gathered to worship God had a deep impact. Life is a series of epiphanies of God because God is infinite. May we have open hearts, and willingness to be like the Magi to take concrete steps to encounter Jesus.

I want to give an update regarding the Diocesan Annual Appeal (DAA). Blessed Sacrament (BSP) recently surpassed its goal of \$57k. That means every additional dollar given to the DAA on behalf of BSP will come back to the parish, so please consider donating if you have not already.

Roncalli Newman (RNC) is doing well at almost 70% of its goal of \$61k. RNC has a larger target because it pays less to Aquinas Schools because of the college ministry. Please consider making a donation to Newman through the DAA.

The more we go past the goals the more our parishes benefit. As I spoke about before, whatever total amount you plan to donate to your parish over the course of the year, take a percentage of that donation and donate it to your parish through the DAA.

As a side note, the Inspired by the Spirit Campaign is for capital projects for both the Diocese and our local parishes that are not covered in the DAA of the parish budgets. Thank you for your support of these endeavors!















