FROM THE DESK OF FR. BILLY DODGE

Lent started this past Wednesday. Perhaps it slipped your mind. It is NOT too late to start! This is a time to return to basics and focus on the three pillars of Lent - prayer, fasting, and almsgiving (service to those in need). I tell people to look at what you are doing, and go to the next level. If you have not been going to Mass every Sunday, start there. If you go every Sunday, then consider going to a daily Mass once or twice a week. Or if you normally pray 10 minutes everyday, try increasing it to 20 or at least 15 minutes. Whatever you normally do in these three areas, step it up to another level.


