The old washer and dryer was not meeting the needs, and will be sent to a new Catholic Charities run group home for young men. This purchase was made using our parish "Works of Charity" accounts. Money for these accounts come from a small stipend from every



wedding I celebrate, from extra Mass stipends because a priest can only accept one stipend each day, along with donations from parishioners specifically for this account. People come to us with all kinds of needs - examples include a funeral for a homeless person, helping a college student with rent, vehicle needs, and much more. A Minute with Jesus

Confession – a preparation for receiving the Eucharist | The best way to prepare to receive Jesus in the Holy Eucharist is by going to Confession (also known as the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Penance). We want to receive Him with a clean heart. If it is not possible to go to Confession before receiving Jesus, make a sincere Act of Contrition in your heart, and as always pray with sincerity the prayer at Mass, "I confess to Almighty God..."

A sin that is mortal – serious or grave – requires Sacramental Confession before receiving Holy Communion. If you are not sure about this, speak with a priest.

•Let's pray this right now and every day this week: *Jesus, please give me the grace to be truly sorry for my sins.*

• This week read how God calls us out of darkness into His own wonderful light in 1 Peter 2:9-10.
