PARISH SURVEYS

There will be two surveys, one for students and one for stationary members. Both surveys will provide information that will be useful for decision-making. It's important to know that majority preference doesn't determine the outcome. Father Billy will consider all factors impacting any changes made at either BSP or RNP.

STUDENT SURVEY: Campus Minister Maddie Stoffel has been helpful in sending out a survey that asks students where and when they are going to Mass, as well as their involvement at Newman. So far, we are tracking student attendance at the 4:30 and 9:00 Masses at Blessed Sacrament, as well as the 11:15 and 8:30 PM Masses at Roncalli Newman. The highest attendance is at the 8:30 PM Mass. Several students prefer an earlier Mass time because it's hard to study after the late Mass.

STATIONARY SURVEY: Tom Schlesinger (RNP parishioner and political scientist who conducted surveys at Gundersen Lutheran) met with Mary Ellen on Friday, May 12th to discuss the stationary member survey. The data we receive will help us recruit liturgical ministers, track parishioner attendance at our various Mass offerings, and develop a list of parishioners interested in social justice outreach, Rosary leadership, bible studies, book studies, and more.
